Did you know that Kelly is not the only new partner joining our team? Look out for our Spring Newsletter to find out more!

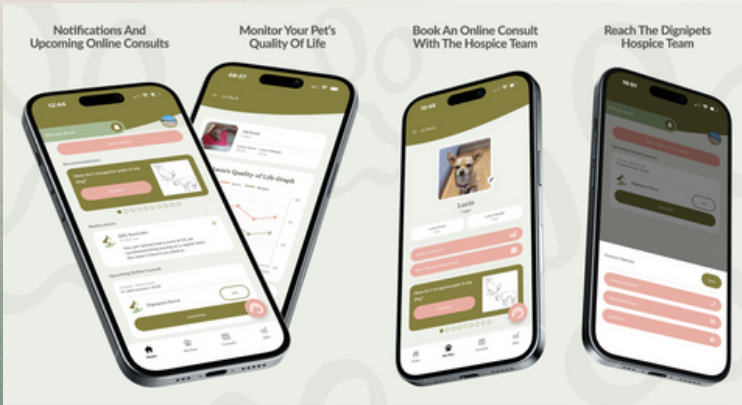

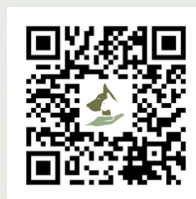
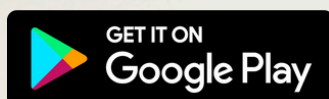
